Thank you for joining our library system! Your MMRLS library card gives you access to millions of books, movies, audiobooks, and e-books, as well as e-resources, public access computers, Wi-Fi, and more. Borrowing Information

Your library card allows you to check out up to 50 items at a time. See below for borrowing information on our most popular items. For complete borrowing information, visit midmisslib.com/borrowing.

Books	2 weeks	50 (10 on new books)	3 (1 on new books)
DVD	1 week	15 (10 on new DVDs)	3 (0 on new DVDs)
Audiobooks	2 weeks	15 (10 on new audiobooks)	3 (1 on new audiobooks)

- If you can't bring your item back on the due date, don't worry! There are no late fees charged for items owned by MMRLS (items owned by other library systems may still be subject to late fees). You'll just need to return your items before checking out more items or using other library services.
- Holds may be placed on up to ten items at a time. Items placed on hold will be held for seven days.
- Items can be checked out and returned at any of our thirteen library branches.
- DVDs and audiobooks cannot be returned in a book drop, though several branch locations have outdoor media return drops.
- Renewals are permitted on most items, unless another patron has a hold on that item. Your items will renew automatically until the renewal limit is reached.
- User groups are created that include minor children and those signing responsibility for them.
- The fee to replace a lost library card is \$2.00.

Technological Services

Computers

- All thirteen MMRLS branch locations have public access computers with Internet access and word processing software.
- You'll use your library card and PIN to log in.
- Children under ten must be accompanied by an adult while using the computer.

Printing Services

- Black and White Print/Copy: .20¢ per page
- Color Print/Copy: \$1.00 per page
- Incoming/Outgoing Fax: \$1.00 per page

Digital Library

- Use your library card and PIN to access thousands of e-books and e-audiobooks with **cloudLibrary**
 - Visit our website and click the cloudLibrary logo, download the cloudLibrary app on your mobile device, or visit ebook.yourcloudlibrary.com/library/Mid-MississippiRegional
 - Click "login" and use your library card and PIN.
 - You may check out up to two items at a time for up to 14 days.
- Instantly borrow digital movies, music, e-books, and more using **Hoopla**
 - Visit our website and click the Hoopla logo, download the Hoopla app to your mobile device, or visit hoopladigital.com.
 - Click on "Get started today" to create an account using your library card and PIN
 - You may check out eight items per month. Checkout periods are as follows:
 - E-books, e-audio, and e-comics: 21 days
 - Music: 7 days
 - Movies and TV: 3 days
